# SERAX



By his own account, Dutch designer Marcel Wolterinck is a huge cooking enthusiast who loves inviting guests to indulge them with culinary delights. He prefers doing so with Japanese dishes. This love for Japanese cuisine inspired him to design the Heii collection for Serax. The trays, plates, bowls, coffee cups, glasses and cutlery embody the meaning of their Japanese name: simplicity and convenience. The collection is modular, the ratios are proportional, all items are nicely attuned to one another. Heii invites creativity for both the dishes and the presentation.

### Minimalist ensemble

The Heii collection is aimed at mutual enjoyment. On the birch trays, you can mix and match the wide variety of different-sized dishes in both white porcelain and grey smoked glass. Serve the dishes without having to take the bowls off the tray, and combine them with the matching coffee cups and water glasses. The cutlery follows the same lines as the plates, dishes and trays from the Heii collection: square and rectangular, but with rounded corners and edges, adding a softer touch to the whole. With Heii by Marcel Wolterinck for Serax, you will have an empty canvas to complete to your own taste.

## MARCEL WOLTERINCK



From a very early age, Dutch designer Marcel Wolterinck has always had a special bond with nature. A bond he would develop further with an education in floral design and floriculture in Nijmegen. Although his great love for nature is still influencing his work today, this multidisciplinary designer did not stay on this path for long. His good taste and keen eye for colour and detail did not go unnoticed. People increasingly inquired about gardens, interiors, colours and shapes. Thus, he developed his own distinctive design style over the years as an autodidact.

Marcel Wolterinck: "A space or object should never be intrusive, it must be subordinate to what the occupant or user wants." Over the course of three decades, his style has evolved into a timeless minimalism, without ever detaching the link with nature. The materials he uses are earthy - natural stone, marble, wood, leather, and even ray skin. And with simple lines and the repetition of materials, he creates a sense of peace. An empty canvas to complete to your own taste, unburdened by the years or fashion trends. 'By Wolterinck' stands for functional designs with a luxurious look.

At first glance, the design of the birch trays from the Heii collection seems simple. However, the protruding edges are concealing the base underneath. This makes it look like the tray is floating, enhancing it with an elegant appearance. The natural grain of the wood is retained by the simple finish, adding a subtle detail to the trays. The small coffee tray is

ideal for serving your guest a cup of coffee accompanied by a glass of water. The large tray was designed for enjoying snacks together with your table companions. The sizes and curves of the trays are perfectly attuned to the dishes and plates of the Heii collection, but the design is so universal that you can use them in countless other ways.

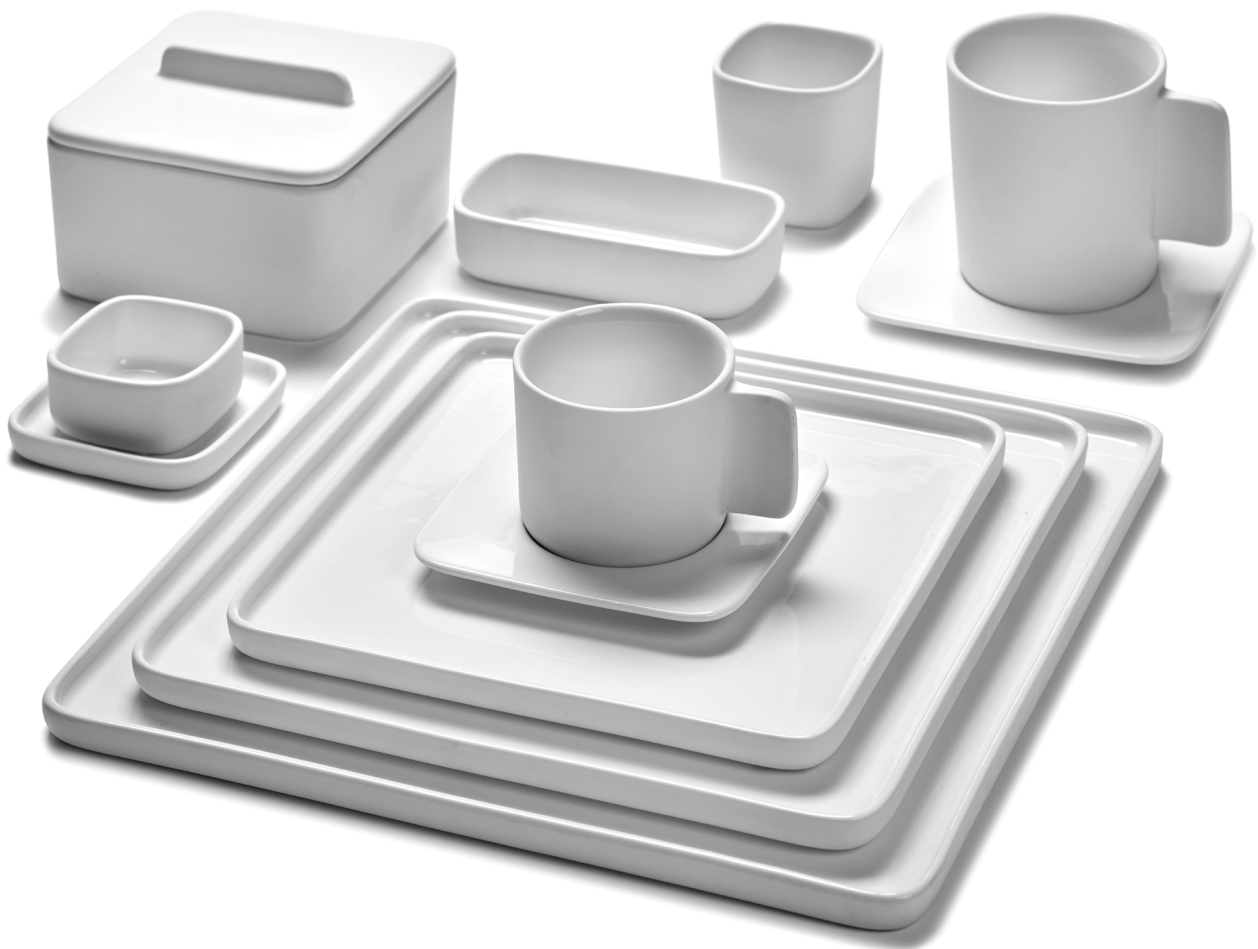

There is no need for plates to always be round. Marcel Wolterinck demonstrates this with his square porcelain plates with raised edges from the Heii collection. A collection that is all about ease of use and sheer simplicity. The six

pearly white plates in different sizes (from 28 to 8 centimetres) fit perfectly together. These dimensions make them suitable for every course, from appetiser to dessert. The smaller versions also fit nicely onto the Heii trays.

Durable porcelain

Main composition : Silicon dioxide (69,74%), Aluminum oxide (19,46%), Ferric oxide (0,25%), Gallium oxide (0,23%), Magnesium oxide (0,24%), Potassium oxide (3,62%)

Finishing : Semi glazed

Firing temperature : 1.300 °C

Production : Traditional molding

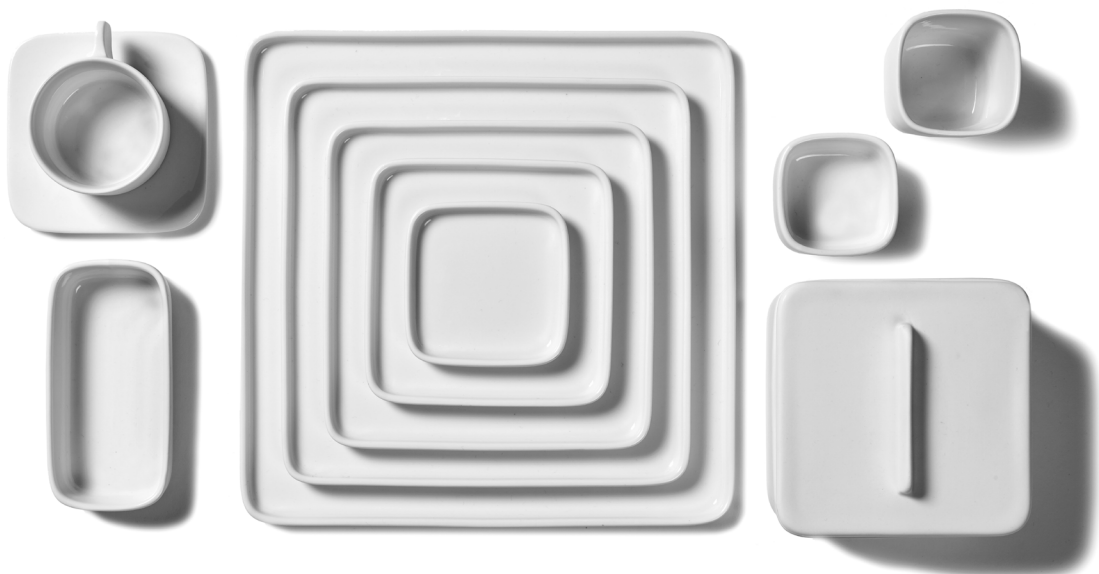

In Japanese, Heii means simplicity. Almost everything that Dutch designer Marcel Wolterinck designs, can be placed under this heading, including the two water glasses from his Heii collection for Serax. The grey, smoked glass adorns them with a stylish élan, and

their sizes are similar to those of the cups from this modular collection. The perfect sparring partner for your cup of coffee on the Heii coffee tray. But even on their own, the glasses are real eye-catchers.

The design of the Heii cutlery builds on Japanese influences and the DNA of the entire collection. Straight lines with contrasting round edges. The nine-piece cutlery set includes table and dessert knives, forks and spoons, a coffee spoon, an espresso spoon, and a butter

knife. The light and dark versions underline the different colours of the tableware collection. The matt brushed stainless steel version follows the porcelain range, while the black PVD coating of the dark version is a nod to the smoked glass.

Stainless steel 18/10, except table knife, dessert knife and butter knife. The knives are made in stainless steel but 18/10 can not be sharpened.  
Official qualities (US norm): knives AISI 420 & other AISI 304  
Finishing version 1: Anthracite pvd coating  
Finishing version 2: Matt polish
